

Temporary Construction Water Service Checklist

- Verify feasibility of proposed service location with GCWSC staff

- Complete and submit the GCWSC Temporary Construction Water Service Application (following page)
 - Please be sure to include all person(s) that applicant authorized to be listed on GCWSC water account. Only people listed on the application will be added to the account. GCWSC staff are not authorized to communicate information about the account status to people that are not listed.

- Completed and submit a GCWSC Temporary Construction Water Service Agreement

- Present Photo ID's for people to be listed on account
 - Must include photo IDs for all persons listed on the Temporary Construction Water Application
 - Acceptable photo IDs include: driver's license, identification certificate, current United Stated passport, foreign passport, or current United States military ID.

- Applicable Fees

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Service Availability Charge (monthly minimum) \$373.50/month. Billed monthly in addition to Gallonage charge. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gallonage Charge - based upon usage per GCWSC Tariff Section G.16. Billed monthly, in addition to Service Availability Charge.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deposit - \$1,500.00 due and payable at time of service application. Payment must be received prior to GCWSC installation of construction meter. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provided that GCWSC's Temporary Service equipment is returned in good repair, the Deposit will be applied to the balance of the final bill and any remaining portion of the Deposit will be refunded to the customer. If GCWSC's equipment is damaged or missing, the Deposit will be applied to the cost to repair or replace that equipment.

In accordance with TCEQ backflow prevention regulations for the protection of GCWSC's drinking water quality and the safety of its customers, a functional RPZ must be installed on the construction meter prior to usage. The RPZ must have a passing test and the passing test report submitted to and on file with GCWSC. The RPZ and test must be furnished by the customer.
